to be as faithful as possible to the original idea. [-More-](#)

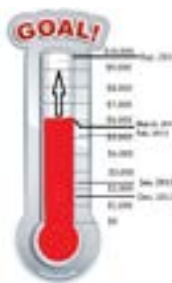
KIDS' DAY OF UNITY
